President's Message

With ski season upon us I thought it a good idea to briefly review skier safety for those of us going skiing this year.

- Ski within your ability (skill level and fitness level)
- Be aware of other skiers around you
- Avoid tree wells
- Study the trail map and do not ski alone
- Use a helmet, sun lotion, eye protection and appropriate clothing for the weather
- Stay hydrated
- Know when to quit. Accidents tend to happen toward the end of the day.
- Know the Code:

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It's your responsibility to avoid them.
3. Don't stop where you obstruct a trail or aren't visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.

Make safe decisions to ensure that your ski vacation will be a success. Have fun out there and see you on the slopes!
